

Privacy Statement

With the following information we would like to give you an overview of the processing of your personal data by us and your rights under data protection law. Which data is processed in detail and how it is used depends to a large extent on the services requested or agreed.

The use of Vectoris AG's Internet pages is possible without any indication of personal data. However, if a person concerned wishes to make use of special services of our company via the website accessed, it may be necessary to process personal data.

The processing of personal data, such as the name, address, e-mail address or telephone number of a person concerned, is carried out in accordance with the requirements of Swiss data protection law. By means of this data protection declaration, our company wishes to inform the public about the nature, scope and purpose of the personal data processed by us. Furthermore, this data protection declaration informs the persons concerned about their rights.

Processing of personal data; type, purpose and their use

When visiting the website

When you visit our website, information is temporarily stored in so-called log files on our server. This is information that the browser of your terminal device automatically sends. By name:

- IP address of the contacting device
- Date and time
- URL of the requested page
- Referred-URL
- Browser and other device information

The data mentioned will be processed by us for the following purposes:

- Establishing a connection to the website
- Use of our website
- System safety and stability

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f DSGVO. Our legitimate interest follows:

- Contract fulfilment:** Data processing is carried out at your request and is necessary for the purposes stated for the fulfilment of the contract and pre-contractual measures in accordance with Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. b DSGVO.
- Consent:** You have given your consent to the data processing described pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. a DSGVO.
- Legal basis:** This processing takes place on the basis of legal foundations,
- Vital interests of the persons concerned or third parties:** Such processing shall be carried out in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person
- Public interest mission:** Such processing shall be carried out in the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority.

Transfer of data to third parties (incl. joint responsible persons and contract data processors)

Your personal data will not be transferred to third parties for purposes other than those listed.

- **Contract handling**

To the extent permitted by law pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. b DSGVO and necessary for the execution of contractual relationships with you, your personal data will be disclosed to third parties.

Cookies

We use cookies (session cookies as well as temporary and permanent cookies) on our website. These are small files that are automatically created by your browser and stored on your device (laptop, tablet, smartphone, etc.) when you visit our site. A cookie does not always mean that we can identify you.

The use of cookies serves on the one hand to record the frequency of use, number of users and behaviour on our website, to increase the security of website use and to make our information offer user-friendly. As soon as you leave the website, these cookies are automatically deleted.

In addition, we also use temporary cookies to optimise user-friendliness, which are stored on your terminal device for a specified period of time. If you visit our site again to make use of our services, it is automatically recognised that you have already been with us and which entries and settings you have made so that you do not have to enter them again.

You can configure your browser settings so that no cookies are stored on your computer. The complete deactivation of cookies may result in you not being able to use all the functions of our website.

By continuing to use our website and/or agreeing to this Privacy Policy, you consent to our setting cookies to collect, store and use personally identifiable information about you, even after the browser session has ended. You can revoke this consent at any time by activating the browser default setting to refuse third-party cookies.

Analysis Tools

Google Analytics

Our website uses the web analysis service Google Analytics of Google Inc., USA. Google Analytics uses cookies (see Cookies). These enable Google to analyse the use of our website including IP addresses in the USA. We would like to point out that on this website Google Analytics was extended by the code "gat._anonymizeIp();" in order to guarantee an anonymous recording of IP addresses (so-called IP masking). If anonymization is active, Google shortens IP addresses within member states of the European Union or in other signatory states to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, which means that no conclusions can be drawn about your identity. Only in exceptional cases is the full IP address transmitted to a Google server in the USA and shortened there. Google complies with the data protection provisions of the "Swiss-USA Privacy Shield" agreement and thus has an adequate level of data protection. Google uses the collected information to evaluate the use of our websites for us, to write reports for us in this regard and to provide us with other relevant services. Responsibility for data protection-compliant operation is to be guaranteed by the respective provider. Data processing in connection with these plug-ins takes place with your consent when you use these plug-ins.

If you use the services of these social networks independently or in connection with our website, the social networks will evaluate your use of the plug-in. In this case, information about the plug-in is passed on to the social networks.

LinkedIn

Plug-ins of the social network LinkedIn Corporation, USA, are installed on our website. You can recognize the LinkedIn plug-in ("LinkedIn Recommended" button) by the LinkedIn logo. When you visit a page on our website that contains such a plug-in, a direct connection is established between your browser and the LinkedIn server. LinkedIn receives the information that you have visited our site with your IP address. If you click on the LinkedIn button while logged into your LinkedIn account, you can link the content of our pages to your LinkedIn profile. This allows LinkedIn to assign the visit to our pages to your user account. XING

Google Maps

Google Maps services are used on our website (e.g. in-screen or via interfaces/API). Google LLC, USA, may therefore process information about your actual location. Google uses various technologies such as IP addresses, GPS, and other sensors to track your location, such as providing Google with information about nearby devices, WLAN access points, or cell towers. Please refer to Google's privacy policy at <https://policies.google.com/privacy?hl=en&gl=en> for the purpose and scope of data collection and the further processing and use of the data by Google, as well as your related rights and privacy settings.

Your Rights

You have the right:

- to request information about your personal data processed by us. In particular, you may request information on the purposes of processing, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data have been or will be disclosed, the planned storage period, the existence of a right of rectification, deletion, restriction of processing or objection, the existence of a right of appeal, the origin of your data if not collected from us, as well as the existence of automated decision-making including profiling and, if applicable, meaningful information on its details (Art. 15 DSGVO). In the event of disproportionately high expenditure, we reserve the right to demand from you in advance an identity card as well as the assumption of the actual costs.
- to demand the correction of incorrect or incomplete personal data stored by us without delay (Art. 16 DSGVO).
- demand the deletion of your personal data stored by us, unless processing is necessary for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and information, for the fulfilment of a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or for the assertion, exercise or defence of legal claims (Art. 17 DSGVO).
- to demand the restriction of the processing of your personal data insofar as the correctness of the data is disputed by you, the processing is unlawful, but you refuse its deletion and we no longer need the data,

but you need it to assert, exercise or defend legal claims or you have lodged an objection against the processing pursuant to Art. 21 DSGVO (Art. 18 DSGVO).

- To receive your personal data, which you have provided to us, in a structured, common and machine-readable format or to request the transfer to another responsible person (Art. 20 DSGVO).
- To revoke your consent to us at any time. As a result, we may no longer continue the data processing based on this consent in the future (Art. 7 para. 3 DSGVO).
- complain to a supervisory authority (see below) (Art. 77 DSGVO).

Right of objection

If your personal data is processed on the basis of legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6 para. 1 sentence 1 lit. f DSGVO, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 21 DSGVO if there are reasons for doing so which arise from your particular situation or if the objection is directed against direct advertising. In the latter case, you have a general right of objection, which is implemented by us without stating a particular situation.
